Satellite Antenna Policy

Plumwood Terrace Condominiums has adopted the following Satellite Antenna Policy for Homeowners to follow when they have questions about the installation of dish antennas.

Rules and Regulations:

- You are **responsible** for any damage that results from the installation or use of any part of the satellite system including damage to the handrail, siding, and balcony.
- You **may** install a dish on your personal balcony hand railing or patio **only as long as the dish and all of the mounting hardware and related assembly is totally within the your balcony or patio**. No part of the dish may extend beyond the railing line or patio line.
- Your dish must be professionally installed.
- You **may not** install the dish on any exterior wall, roof, siding or any other common element.
- You agree to hold Plumwood Terrace Condominiums and the managing agent harmless for any personal or physical damage to the property or persons as a result of damage or injury by the dish.
- Plumwood Terrace Condominiums reserves the right to make changes or alter this policy including removal of the dish antenna by providing at least 30 days notice.

Satellite Installation for Railings



Installation of the dish antenna can be accomplished on a steel baluster measuring from 3/8 to 1.5 inches.

Satellite Installation for Balconies and Patios



Installation of the dish antenna can be accomplished by setting a pole in a concrete filled planter.
